The New Regime

Dear colleagues, friends, ladies and gentlemen,

We consider it necessary to speak about the developments relating to the Nobility's communications with the European Union and some of its member states from two months ago. We further bring attention to their aftermath, global instability, the state of international law, and the direction of the Nobility International and its implications for the international community, particularly our European brethren.

In the month of May, the Nobility International Ambassador transmitted a message of solidarity to the foreign offices of the European Union and key member states, informing them, among other matters, of the Nobility International's position, commitment, and means of achieving its objectives. Central to this diplomatic mission was the objective of encouraging cooperation with the French Republic in the area of military integration and the creation of a European military. Following these communications, a number of encouraging developments have taken place.

To the objective of military integration, we are pleased to witness the Kingdom of Denmark's decision to join the European Union's shared defence policy. Being a natural descendant of the shared defence policy, a future European military stands to benefit from this inclusion.

Last month, the European Union agreed on a resolution to trigger Article 48 which enables it to amend its treaties. Those in support of this resolution, such as European Parliament Member Mr. Guy Verhofstadt, seek to abolish voter unanimity. By removing every individual members' *de facto* right to veto, the European Parliament will finally be free to impose its direction upon the disgruntled minority of members who stand in the way of progress. Thus, it is to our great delight that one of the biggest obstacles to a unified European military has now been removed.

In the Ambassador's communications, it was specifically recommended to pursue the military integration of Ukraine into the European Union as an alternative to NATO membership. Two weeks ago, the European family grew with the inclusion of Ukraine and the Republic of Moldova as candidates to the European Union, and the recognition

of Georgia's European perspective. We remain optimistic for the continuation of such developments and we reiterate, to the European Union and its member states, our commitment to cooperating towards the objective of favourable arms manufacturing legislation and to developing the European arms industry in furtherance of European security objectives and independence.

Despite these encouraging developments, a number of obstacles remain in the way of our mutual strategic interests. Chief among these is American influence in European matters which seeks to keep Europeans dependent on American protection, via the NATO alliance. As the Nobility International Ambassador has noted to his colleagues in the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Finland, the urgency of the Eastern security situation warrants immediate and desperate measures, such as NATO membership, despite the cultural consequences of American influence. Nevertheless, it remains the case that European self-determination cannot coexist with dependence upon the United States of America.

We must state the obvious clearly and frankly: an armyless Europe cannot pursue an independent agenda. So long as Europe depends on American security and weaponry, European interests will be sacrificed wherever they conflict with American ones. We encourage European fathers to see for themselves what American freedom has done to little European girls. Let Europe see America's chemical sterilization and sexual mutilation of prepubescent children, and the American officials who publicly defend this sexual abuse and the perverted medical professionals who continue to irreparably ruin children's lives. Let Europe see how America defends its gun laws when their children are being shot in schools. Let Europe see the members of the Washington establishment who "partied" with convicted pedophile Jeffrey Epstein on his private island.

Are these grotesque American human rights violations what our European colleagues wish to associate themselves with? We encourage you to think carefully if this is truly the case. We remind you that your names and faces will be associated to your actions, because Europeans do not, in fact, support American child abuse, school shootings, and blackmailed politicians. Are you willing to go against the will of Europe and jeopardize the legitimacy of your respective governments, or worse, that of the European Union?

To those of you who answer to the affirmative, then let us point your attention to the legitimacy crisis which preceded the fall of the Soviet Union. History teaches us that when the gun is the only thing left to keep you in power, it is not a matter of "if" you will lose it, but "when". With Europe's dependence on American security in mind, we submit the following facts to you candidly.

25% of Americans support the violent overthrow of their own government. Roughly 50% of Americans support the Russian Federation's "special military operation", solely to see their government suffer a loss. 88% of Americans disapprove of their country's

direction. More than a third of Americans regularly reject the results of U.S. federal elections. 40% of Americans did not trust life-saving recommendations made by the World Health Organization when it came from the mouths of American officials or Western media. Last year, the United States government had to forcefully put down a violent insurrection in its capital. This year, every branch of the U.S. military has failed to meet its recruitment goals, despite a sign-up bonus of up to fifty thousand dollars in effect; apparently, perverts are not worth dying for. It is clear that American security is not as secure as our European colleagues think it is.

Of course, Europe is not immune to the effects of America's legitimacy crisis. In recent years, Western women can be seen expressing vitriol at powerful Western men, even going as far as to label them a "patriarchy", while welcoming into their countries even more patriarchal men. Moreover, Western elites are looking for alternatives to ideologically-driven academic institutions, in a manner similar to the post-Reformation decline in university attendance by aristocrats – an event which led to the collapse of Western academic institutions in the 17th century.

In February of this year, the American world order collapsed. Despite American sanctions, the non-Western world stood by President Putin; to the contrary, it is the West who is isolating itself as a result of the sanctions. In conjunction with the supply disruptions caused by the pandemic, the West now experiences inflation levels that younger generations have only read of in their history books. Currently, there are ongoing riots, throughout the West, in opposition to the rise in food and energy prices.

Dear colleagues, American decline continues to accelerate and you can rest assured that the Washington establishment has every intention of dragging you down with them. Whether you wish to remain on the Titanic or not is entirely up to you. We will take note of that decision, and so will the Russian Federation and the People's Republic of China. The clock is ticking on your comfort and luxurious lifestyles.

With regards to President Putin's recent prediction of a "change of elites", we highlight that Mr. Putin is merely making an observation – one which does not require a genius intellect to make. We reiterate what has already been said: it is not a matter of "if", but "when" will the New Regime replace the current Washington establishment in its control over American institutions. It is our "prediction" that Western elections are going to get a lot more interesting, as of the next decade; there is a new player on the table.

As we speak, there are good well-meaning American patriots within the Washington establishment who share the European public's outrage; these individuals can be found among U.S. military generals, Hollywood directors, lobbyists, academics, industrialists, fathers, veterans, and so on. Under the administration of the New Regime, perverts and their apologists will be prosecuted with the full force of American law, and those American heroes within the Washington establishment who cooperate with the New Re-

gime's anti-pervert Inquisition will be absolved of all prosecution and financial consequences. A resolution is currently in the works in the Supreme Committee to offer such an asylum program to these brave men and women who stand on the right side of history.

Dear colleagues, are we to let Russia and China dictate the terms of the new world order? The future of America is in the hands of the New Regime and this new elite supports only a noble world order of international law. For the sake of clarity, we will say this very plainly. International law is a demarcation line that separates law-abiding nations and criminal regimes, and the law is something which must be enforced with the legitimate use of state force. We remind you that our dedication to achieving the supremacy of international law and the United Nations' statehood is enshrined in the Nobility International charter – the law is not up for debate.

Thus, there are two competing world orders: President Putin's multi-polar world order or the New Regime's noble world order. Members of the Washington establishment, take note: you are with us or you are against us. In the coming weeks, we will keep the public informed in regards to the asylum program. Those of you who choose to cooperate, it is our promise to you: we will keep you safe and comfortable.

The United States of America is a country with a tremendous potential for good. It is time for the New Regime to unleash it. The American public has spoken: enough is enough, the Washington establishment must go.
