



**Resolution Adopted by the
Subcommittee of Culture and Society
on June 21, 2022**

Apolloism

Whereas the Noble Families of the Nation of Aristopolis have expressed their greater identification with the term “Apollonian”,

Whereas these Noble Families have been compelled to abandon the term “Perfectionist”,

The Subcommittee of Culture and Society,

Subject to the approval of the Supreme Committee,

Having considered the Nobilitas’ Nominal Amendment request of June 21, 2022, intended to amend the Nobility International Code of Ethics,

Acknowledges the failure of the term “Perfectionist” to sufficiently relate to the Apollonian faith of these Noble Families,

Highlights the foundational role of Apolloism with respect to the Noble identity,

Amends the Nobility International Code of Ethics to reflect this preference,

Discloses its intent to spread Apollonian influence to the international community,

Requests the Supreme Committee to approve this resolution’s entry into force.

Article 1

1.1 “Apollonian” shall mean an adherent of Apolloism.

1.2 “Aristophile” shall mean an Apollonian ally of the Noble community – a righteous human.

1.3 “Professional Apollonian” shall mean an Apollonian who dedicates his or her time to the Perfectionment of humanity on a full-time basis.

1.4 “Registered Apollonian” shall mean a Professional Apollonian who is registered with the Board of Ethics.

1.5 “NICE” shall mean the Nobility International Code of Ethics.

Article 2

No Apollonian shall cooperate, collaborate, assist, or in any way associate with anyone who deceptively uses the title of “Registered Apollonian” or makes one believe that he or she is a Registered Apollonian, unless the person is registered with the Board of Ethics.

Article 3

All Apollonians shall be expected to abide by the NICE.

Article 4

Apollonians shall respect and command respect, at all times.

Article 5

Apollonians shall use generally recognized scientific and professional principles in the exercise of any professional activity.

Article 6

Apollonians shall always take into account the consequences of their activities upon humanity.

Article 7

Apollonians shall fulfill their professional obligations with competence, integrity, objectivity, and care.

Article 8

Apollonians are prohibited from misrepresenting their competence, the effectiveness of their own activities, or those of Apollonians, in general.

Article 9

Apollonians shall take reasonable measures to ensure that any 3rd party involved in the Apollonian's activities complies with the NICE.

Article 10

Apollonians shall take into account the client's demands and expectations as well as the limits of the skills and means at the Apollonian's disposal.

Article 11

Apollonians are prohibited from providing professional services to minors and anyone who has not explicitly expressed consent.

Article 12

Apollonians shall respect the privacy of people with whom they have a professional relationship, in particular by refraining from collecting information and exploring aspects of private life which have no connection with the professional services of the Apollonian.

Article 13

Apollonians shall disclose nothing about a client unless the client has explicitly consented to the disclosure, law enforcement has an appropriate warrant, or if disclosing the information to law enforcement would result in the saving of a life or the cessation of harm.

Article 14

In a professional context, Apollonians are prohibited from placing their personal interests above that of their clients, or that of humanity.

Article 15

Apollonians are prohibited from providing professional services if it would have the appearance of impropriety.

Article 16

Apollonians shall, at all times, engage in exemplary behavior reflective of the class, ethics, and vision of their Nobility.
