



**Resolution Adopted by the
Subcommittee of International Relations
on March 15, 2022**

Aachen Declaration

*The Subcommittee of International Relations,
Subject to the approval of the Supreme Committee,
Having considered the formal recommendation of the Nobility International Security Institute
("NISI") published on March 15, 2022,*

*Having further considered the recommendation of the Subcommittee of Security within the
Aachen Resolution,*

*Determined to implement and proliferate the new approach to international relations proposed
by the NISI,*

Agreeing to formally reference this approach as the Aachen Doctrine,

1. *Recognizes* the European nation's distinct and, at times, conflicting interests from those of the United States of America,

2. *Classifies* 3 entities involved in the ongoing war between Ukraine and the Russian Federation:

- (a) Europe;
- (b) the United States of America;
- (c) the Russian Federation;

2. *Adopts* the Aachen Doctrine, as described below:

(a) one can only have an allegiance to Europe, the United States of America, or the Russian Federation;

(b) those who have previously declared an allegiance to Europe commit treason by professing a new allegiance to the United States of America or the Russian Federation;

(c) all entities who betray Europe shall henceforth be collectively known as the *Traitors' Coalition*;

(d) all members of the Traitors' Coalition are hereby considered adversaries of the Nobility International;

(e) individual aristophiles and aristophilian organizations are hereby prohibited from entering into economic, political, or legal relationships with any member of the Traitors' Coalition;

(f) all members of the Traitors' Coalition shall be given only one chance to renounce the Traitors' Coalition and reaffirm their allegiance to Europe;

3. *Emphasizes* the Nobility International's commitment to enforcing the Aachen Doctrine with economic incentives afforded by the Nobility International Dollar Agency;

4. *Recommends* the European Union and its member states to take the Aachen Doctrine into account in their dialogues with the Nobility International Ambassador;

5. *Mandates* the Internationalist Neoliberal Canadian Elites' Party to adopt the Aachen Doctrine as part of Canada's foreign policy and to support a bilateral security agreement between Canada and the European Union;

Therefore,

The Subcommittee of International Relations extends a stern warning to the members of the Traitors' Coalition with the recommendation that they take note of the Aachen Doctrine,

Requests the Supreme Committee to approve this resolution's entry into force.
