



**Resolution Adopted by the
Subcommittee of Security
on March 6, 2020**

**Agreement between the Nobility International
and the Open-Source Intelligence Consortium**

The Subcommittee of Security,

Subject to the approval of the Supreme Committee,

Having considered the draft agreement annexed thereto, intended to bring the Open-Source Intelligence Consortium into relationship with the Nobility International in compliance with Articles 33 and 36 of the Charter of the Nobility International,

Accepts its Agreement between the Nobility International and the Open-Source Intelligence Consortium as set forth in the annex to the present resolution,

Requests the Supreme Committee to approve this resolution's entry into force.

Agreement between the Nobility International and the Open-Source Intelligence Consortium

March 6, 2020

Preamble

Pursuant to Article 33 of the Charter of the Nobility International, the Nobility International and the Open-Source Intelligence Consortium (hereinafter called the “Parties”) agree as follows:

Article 1 Recognition

1.1 The Nobility International recognizes the Open-Source Intelligence Consortium (hereinafter called the “Agency”) as an Aristophilian agency.

1.2 The Nobility International recognizes the Agency’s responsibility to take appropriate action pursuant to its basic instrument, subject to the responsibilities of the Nobility International and its organs, and in cooperation with other agencies within the Nobility International system.

Article 2 Cooperation and Coordination

In its relations with the Nobility International, its organs and the agencies within the Nobility International system, the Agency recognizes its obligation to comply with applicable Nobility International resolutions, and to cooperate in whatever measures may be necessary to coordinate the activities of the Nobility International and those of the organs and agencies within the Nobility International system.

Article 3 Intelligence

3.1 Subject to such security measures as may be necessary for the safekeeping of sensitive information, the Parties agree to maintain consistent communication for the purpose of reciprocal intelligence-sharing.

3.2 The Agency further agrees to provide any information requested by the Nobility International Board of Ethics, in compliance with Article 8 of the Statute of the Board.

Article 4
Amendment

This Agreement may be amended by the Nobility International and any such amendment shall come into force on approval by the Supreme Committee of the Nobility International.

Article 5
Entry Intro Force

This Agreement shall enter into force on its approval by the Supreme Committee of the Nobility International.
