**Resolution Adopted by the  
Subcommittee of Security  
on March 15, 2022**

**Aachen Resolution**

*The Subcommittee of Security,  
Subject to the approval of the Supreme Committee,  
Having considered the formal recommendation of the Nobility International Security Institute  
published on March 15, 2022,*

*Recognizing the nationhood of a united Europe with unique and legitimate interests,*

*Acknowledging the necessity of a united European army as a prerequisite for the self-mastery  
and self-determination of the European nation,*

*Appalled by Europe's dependence on the United States of America to fulfill its security needs,*

*Noting the American role in creating conditions favourable for the violent escalation of the con-  
flict between Ukraine and the Russian Federation,*

*Highlighting the inability of an armyless Europe to pursue its own agenda free from American  
pressure since WWII,*

*Reiterating the sexually perverted nature of American culture and the psychological abuse it in-  
flicts upon European children,*

*Concerned by the United Nations' inability to independently enforce international law by milit-  
ary means,*

1. *Urges* Nobility International Member Families within the governments of the French Republic and the Federal Republic of Germany to promote:

(a) building upon the Treaty on Franco-German Cooperation and Integration (the “Aachen Treaty”) with the legal commitment of both parties to a united Franco-German military;

(b) further inclusion of all European Union member states as parties to the Aachen Treaty;

(c) legislation at the level of the European Union replacing its existing security architecture with the implementation and centralized administration of the expanded Aachen Treaty;

2. *Demands* Nobility International Member Families within the European Union to advance:

(a) cooperation with the present and future parties to the Aachen Treaty by prioritizing legislation pertaining to the expanded Aachen Treaty;

(b) the formation of separate bilateral security agreements with Canada and the Commonwealth of Australia;

(c) the protection of the children of Europe and humanity by replacing America as the international community’s dominant exporter of culture;

(d) the establishment of a bilateral dialogue with the Russian Federation with the objective of finding a peaceful resolution to the war in Ukraine;

(e) a constructive dialogue on the enforcement of international law in cooperation with the United Nations;

3. *Directs* the Open-Source Intelligence Consortium to monitor the public activities and note the voting records of all politicians who neglect to protect European children from American culture;

4. *Recommends* the Subcommittee of International Relations to mandate the Internationalist Neoliberal Canadian Elites’ Party to support a bilateral security agreement between Canada and the European Union;

*Therefore,*

*The Subcommittee of Security expresses* the sincere hope that the European Union and its member states will heed the recommendations of the Nobility International outlined in the present resolution,

*Requests* the Supreme Committee to approve this resolution’s entry into force.
